Camp Applications are in! They are available in the hallway. Please sign for any you take and indicate if they are for yourself or for a friend. Sunday School pays the camp fee (\$175) for members of the Sunday School or Wednesday evening program. The church will pay the camp fee (\$175) for any first-time camper you invite. All campers are responsible for the registration fee.

On Sunday, April 29th, all of the Jr. Church will be worshipping in the sanctuary for the 8:15 service. For the 10:30 service, all children in 1st grade and up will worship in the sanctuary. Children 3 years-old through kindergarten will remain downstairs for Jr. Church.

Nurseries

- * There is an unstaffed nursery for babies located on the same floor as the sanctuary that may be used at any time.
- * For the 10:30 Worship Service, we have a staffed nursery downstairs in room 1 for children up through the age of 3.
- * Feel free to use the downstairs nursery even if it is not staffed.
- * Both nurseries have a closed circuit TV through which you can watch the worship service.

Jr. Church (8:15 & 10:30 Worship Services)

- * We offer a Jr. Church program during both morning worship services downstairs in the social room for children age 3 up to and including 6th grade.

Should my 3 year-old be in the nursery or Jr. Church?

- * If your child is going to turn 4 before September 1st, your child should be in Jr. Church.
- * If your child is going to turn 4 on or after September 1st, your child should be in the nursery until the first Sunday in September of this year.
- * If you would like your 3 year-old to be in Jr. Church before he/she is supposed to be in Jr. Church, then you need to stay with your child during Jr. Church each Sunday until a leader says it is okay to leave.

Sunday School (9:30)

- * We have classes for children (beginning when they are old enough to walk), youth, and adults. If your child is not old enough to walk, feel free to take him/her with you to your class. For more info, please see either the Sunday School brochure or the Welcome Packet. They are located in the pew rack and on a table in the hallway.
